Guidelines for Providing “Mission Moments” During Sunday Worship Services

A “Mission Moment” is an opportunity for the congregation and members of Trinity United Methodist Church to be made aware of mission efforts that are directly related to and/or support the mission and ministry of Trinity United Methodist Church and its function.

“Mission Moments” are announcements made during Sunday Worship Services. Some examples of mission moments that meet the above criteria include: Appalachian Service Project, Stewardship, Trinity Disaster Relief Team, Movie Night, Homeless Shelter Project and other events or missions being hosted or sanctioned by Trinity UMC, and State of the Church reports by our Administrative Board and Board of Trustees.

The following guidelines have been established by the Staff/Parish Relations Committee:

The Pastor’s Advisory Committee may provide assistance and recommendations to the ministry leadership about the appropriateness of any request for a “Mission Moment”.

All “Mission Moments” should be limited to a maximum of a three minute presentation in order to provide for the integrity of the worship service.

Announcements or activities that do not meet the above guidelines for a “Mission Moment” could be provided an opportunity to place an announcement in the Trinity Trumpet, a special insert in the weekly bulletin and/or available on Trinity’s web site.

Examples that would meet inclusion in the Trinity Trumpet publication and/or Trinity’s web site might be requests for donations, requests for volunteers for outside community events, or opportunities to make Trinity members aware of larger community events.
